Together, we continue to make The Center a place where people connect, learn, laugh, and belong. Let's make this a summer to remember!

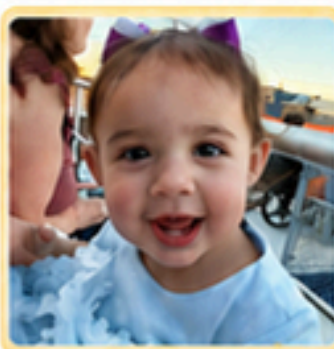
